


Water Use and Supply Overview Water Use & Projections **Water Supply** Decreased since 2013/14 to Groundwater (OC Basin) below 10-yr avg. In 2020 ~ 94% of supply In 2045 ~ 95% of supply Projecting to increase in 25 yrs **Recycled Water** ~2% increase now to 2025 In 2020 ~6% of supply ~21% increase between 2025 – In 2045 ~5% of supply 2045 Supplemental Imported Water Back to 2013/14 level of total use In 2020 = 0% of supply in 2035 June 2045 = 0% of supply DISTRICT



Key Findings of 2020 UWMP


Mesa Water has **long-term** (25 yrs) water service reliability under average year, single dry year, five consecutive drought years

Mesa Water has **near-term** (5 yrs) supply capabilities sufficient for a drought period lasting five consecutive years

Mesa Water has plans for supply implementation investments to meet its projected water demands

Appendix K Addendum to 2015 UWMP Reduced Delta Reliance Reporting 12 | June 10, 2021

DWR Issued Guidance on Delta Plan Policy

District's reporting is consistent with approach detailed in UWMP Guidebook and MET's and MWDOC's 2020 UWMP

- Set a water use baseline (2010)
- Calculate water use efficiency since baseline (out to 2045)
- Calculate change in per capita use since baseline (GPCD)
- Calculate supplies contributing to regional self-reliance (i.e. water use efficiency programs, water recycling, groundwater replenishment) (out to 2045)
