

Capital Charge

- Capital Charge is a Fee
- Covers maintenance, repair, and rehabilitation of Water System



Capital Charge Rationale

- Appropriate for the property owner to pay for long-term capital investments
- Provide a set revenue stream for necessary maintenance, repair and rehabilitation of the water system
- Stabilize revenue due to seasonal events such as rain or mandatory cutbacks





Method & Timing of Collection

- Board has authority to set Capital Charge (CA H&S Code 5471)
- Capital Charge will be collected through the Orange County Treasurer-Tax Collector
- Capital Charge goes into effect January 2023
- First two assessments will be paid December 2022 & April 2023
